Categories:	Divisions:
- Right Whale (Open): Everyone is allowed to compete in this category	- Men's: at least 4 male rowers
- Pilot Whale (high school): Rowers must be at least 14 y/o and under 18 y/o, Boatsteerer must be a trained adult	- Women's: all female rowers
- Blue Whale (Masters): Rowers average age 50 y/o	- Co-ed: at least 2 female rowers and at least 1 male rower
- Grey Whale (Senior): Rowers average age 60 y/o	
- Beluga Whale (Non competitive) This category is for new comers or individuals who want to participate but may not feel experienced enough to compete.

Entrance Fee

- 25.00 per person - Checks made payable to BBRC- please submit one payment per team

Race

- One-day event. Approximately a 1- mile race with 4 turns. Best time in each Category/Division win. (Exception of Beluga non competitive)
