BOARD/GENERAL MINUTES

Meeting was called to order at the Sail Loft by President Heidi Hacking at 7:13 PM

The minutes of the May meeting were read and accepted.

Treasurer Report. Barbara T distributed copies of the Financial Report and noted that two donations were received; one for \$40.00 from the Day of Portugal Committee, and one from the Lorelei team for \$700. These are to be deposited in the boat fund. She also reported that the volunteer donations from membership renewals exceeded the amount collected in 2013 by \$300.00. These, too, are earmarked for the boat fund which now stands at \$7,498. The operating account is \$18,988.06.

Thank you letters were received from Bishop Stang High School in appreciation of the donation of two Club memberships for their auction; the Animal Shelter for contributions of needed items and cash given in Gail Isaksen's name; and the Lite the Lighthouse restoration group, money generated from the relay co -sponsored by the BBRC and Low Tide Yacht Club.

Taskforce/Committee Reports

Open Water Challenge. June 7, 2014. Nancy A, event chair, went over the list of volunteer slots still open and reported that the sprints will have 6 teams, rather than the usual 5, and the long race, 3 BBRC teams. Barbara T mentioned that the Azorean boat will be going into the water and may field a team. Nancy has obtained a food permit and has touched base with the person in charge of ordering a clean Port a John and removing the stanchion allowing visiting boats clear access to the beach. Applications from outside Clubs and individuals have been coming in.

Upcoming Races/Events

Spring clean-up. A satisfactory number of volunteers showed up and everything looks great. The *Phoenix*, whose cleaning was postponed due to the weather, will be cleaned and painted at a convenient date later.

Waterfire. Too much is going on the week-end of the 15th, and since key people who tow and participate are not available, the BBRC will not take part this year.

Morgan Events. Heidi went over some of the events surrounding the arrival of the Charles B Morgan which is to arrive in New Bedford the end of June. Upon its arrival, boats are invited to greet it (informally) as it enters the Harbor. Since there is no definite time, whomever is available will be welcome to row...teams who happen to have a scheduled time slot, will not be displaced, but will be able to row their hour as usual. On the 29th there will be a formal parade. The BBRC with 3 boats and a bow rider will have room for 21 participants. The Board will have preference, seconded by those 26 individuals who signed up when the notice went out. The Azorean boats will be participating and many members may row there, as well as, in the gigs. This increases the opportunity to be a part of this special event for a number of members. On July 5 there will be races and a skills contest, and the next day sail races between the Azorean boats and Morgan whaleboats. Whaling City rowing is organizing the whaleboat races. The Morgan will leave New Bedford July 7th.

Light the Bay Regatta. Due to a conflict in dates, the event has been cancelled.

ROWNEast. No contact, no action.

Getting Organized. Heidi explained that certain offices and Club business needs to be backed up in the event that the person holding that position becomes unable to carry on. The President is backed up by the Vice President and the Secretary's job can be easily reassigned. The Treasurer's job, however, is very complex and, with the addition of membership responsibilities, is really too much to expect of one person holding down a full time job. Therefore, the following changes have been suggested;
